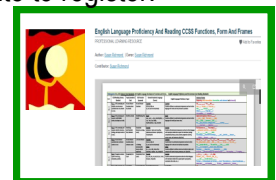
**Message from the Director (Tool Kit)**

**Why can't I add new students in TIDE?** You can, but only after the student’s previous school has deleted the student from their TIDE file. It is not possible to list a student at two schools in TIDE. Attempting to do so will prompt an error message that says “User not authorized.” To resolve this problem we are asking all schools to delete their former students **as soon as possible**. If it is possible to determine a student’s previous school, the process can be expedited by contacting that school and requesting the deletion.
